

What is U3A?

U3A stands for the University of the Third Age, which is a self-help organisation for older people no longer in full time employment.

It is not a University in the traditional sense but an organisation that can provide this age group with educational, creative and leisure opportunities in friendly fellowship.

It aims to tap the reservoir of knowledge, experience and organisational skills found among older people to create self-help learning groups.

The planning, administration, teaching and organisation is carried out by members on a voluntary basis.

The annual subscription is \$10 to cover the overheads of the organisation and the production of a quarterly newsletter.

Many groups meet in members' homes but larger groups may have to rent rooms, which usually incurs a small additional charge.

Each U3A, - there are 64 in New Zealand, is autonomous, but a single subscription allows you to join any of the courses in other U3A's, if places are available.

Each course has a Convenor to plan the course in response to members' wishes
