What is the U3a

The U3A is the title adopted internationally from its original beginnings as the “University of the 3rd Age” in France in 1972.

Not a University in the traditional meaning but an organisation that can help older people to learn new skills and experience social gatherings.

The U3A has spread throughout the world and came to NZ in 1979.

The U3A aims to tap the reservoir of knowledge, experience and organisational skills found among older people, and to produce self-help and mutual aid learning groups.

The planning, administration, teaching and organisation is carried out by members on a voluntary basis.

The annual subscription is \$10 to cover the overheads of the organisation and newsletters.

Many groups take place in members’ homes but larger groups may have to rent rooms and there may be a small additional charge.

Each U3A is autonomous but a single subscription allows you to join any of the courses in other U3A’s if places are available.

Each course has a Convenor to plan the course in response to members’ wishes.
