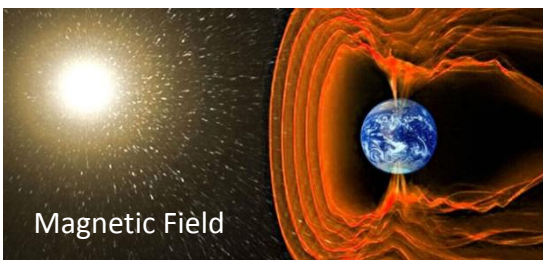
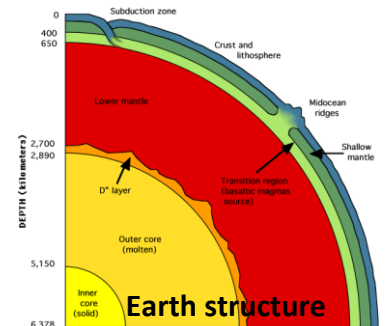
News and reports from some of our groups:

Geology Group Report

We started the year looking at the structure of the earth with its solid nickel-iron solid core and liquid iron outer core where convection currents and earth rotation creates the earth's magnetic field. Then the mantle composed of mainly silica based rocks with a hot plastic upper layer on which the continental and oceanic plates float and where hot magma is produced volcanic activity. Finally above this is our very thin crust where we live.

Continental drift shows how NZ is caught in a grip between subduction zones riding under South Island creating the Alpine fault system and another zone forcing its way under the east Coast of North Island. These conflicting forces meet under the South Island around Seddon, and the Cobb valley forming an unstable environment of Earthquakes which are occurring around Christchurch, Kaikoura, Seddon, Fiordland and across to Wellington. Other topics have been on sedimentary rocks; rising sea levels and the earth's magnetic field.

8000 years ago the Neolithic farmers could walk from Ireland to Britain, France and the Netherlands without getting wet. Dogger Bank was a hill in **Doggerland**; not a fishing area for North Sea cod. Sea levels rose **400 feet** in a short period creating the Irish Sea, North Sea and the English Channel without the industries, Power



stations and oil base transport.

Also evidence is accumulating that the Earth's magnetic field is rapidly moving and weakening and heading for a reversal which will may accelerate global warming and release high levels of solar radiation on the earth.
